

Definition of fake news

Fake news or Hoax are false stories that were invented with the intent to mislead in order to gain financially or politically, normally they are exaggerated, or patently false headlines that are used to grab attention.

It can be a text, photos or videos.



Types of fake news

Fabricated content

-The content is 100% false, designed to deceive and do harm

Satire

-No intention to cause harm but has intention to fool

Manipulation

-when genuine information or images are manipulated to deceive

Fake News Can Affect Your Grades

Fake News Makes It Harder For People To See the Truth

A study suggests that fake-news panic, rather than driving people to abandon ideological outlets, it's driving consumers to drop some outlets, to simply consume less information overall, and even to cut out social relationships."

Deepfakes

In deepfakes, this means changing one person's face into another's, in ways a human editor might not think of or would be unable to detect.

The "deep" in deepfake refers to "deep learning". It's this element, and the fact the faces are generated by a computer, that makes deepfakes different to — and potentially more dangerous than — fakes that have been manually created by humans.

It can be used to fake a political speech or a famous person, causing a controversy.

Fake news is false or misleading information presented as news. It often has the aim of damaging the reputation of a person or entity, or making money through advertising revenue. However, the term does not have a fixed definition, and has been applied more broadly to include any type of false information, including unintentional and unconscious mechanisms, and also by high-profile individuals to apply to any news unfavourable to their personal perspectives.
